**1** Title of Proposal

An act to require the General Secretary to produce reasonably minimal standard templates for forms

**2** Summary of Changes Provisioned

This proposal may be cited as the Standard Template (Limitations) Act 2026.

Although it makes sense to include certain things not strictly required to be on forms (e.g. this summary field!), we should not give the General Secretary unbridled discretion in doing so.

Forms; templates; requirements; form.

3 Provisions

A player may include a request for information on a standard template for a form if and only if:

(a) the information is required by the rules to be present on the form, or

(b) the request satisfies the requirements to be a permissible extension to the standard template for that form.

Forms; templates; requirements; form.

**3** Provisions  
A request for information is a permissible extension to a standard template for a form if and only if:

- (a) the request is for information reasonably related to that already to be on the form, and
- (b) the request would not unduly extend the time or effort required to complete the template.
